Facility will be set up as needed before lecture/workshop.

Workshops have a maximum of 20 students. Additional students considered at \$20.00 each if space allows without crowding. No more than two students per 3" X 8" table. Adequate light must be provided. Tables need to be sturdy.

Sewing/quilting workshops require adequate electrical outlets for machines and irons. One iron and ironing board for each 5 students. 1 machine available for demonstration—I do not mind using student's machines.

Surface Design classes must have plenty of ventilation and easy access to water. Floors should be easy to clean.

Workshops Available:

LANDSCAPE INTERPRETATION

Learn the method to easily turn your photo into your work of art. Participants bring a photo of their choice. We will learn to select fabrics that will interpret the various elements in the photo, how to assemble them, and discuss the quilting possibilities.

One day class. Fee: \$780

ASPENS!

Students turn two pieces of white silk into their own aspen design. This workshop involves, dyeing, painting, and assembling the quilt tops. Quilting ideas will be demonstrated. This workshop works well for a weekend retreat! Supplies are included in this workshop.

Two day workshop. Fee: \$1200

THREAD PAINTING

Learn to use your sewing machine to create a scene using thread! Bring your photo, learn to transfer it to fabric, then learn the ins and outs of covering your canvas with threads!

One day class. Fee \$780

MACHINE QUILTING

Ready to dive into the free-motion world? Come and play. We will learn the steps to creating pleasing quilting lines. I will guide you into the process gently. It is really fun and does not have to be intimidating. It does take practice. Let's go over the basics and get in some practice time while learning to relax while you quilt. Some supplies provided.

Half-day class. Fee: \$500.

DYE PLAY WORKSHOP

Learn the basics of dyeing fabric with Procion Fiber Reactive Dyes. We will discuss mixing, color, value, and safety. I will provide the dyes and chemicals needed for you to dye your own fabric. Come prepared to play! This is great for a retreat!

Two day workshop. Fee: \$1200

LECTURE/TRUNK SHOW

My presentation takes the group from my very first quilt—and my very first art quilt (which never fails to get lots of laughs)—through my journey into the world of art quilts. I bring a variety of quilts to show and discuss the process of taking them from an idea to the finished piece.

Fee: \$500

SALES: Gay may bring dyed fabric and scarves to sell. No class or lecture time is taken up by selling. The guild/conference will not expect to collect a commission from such sales.

There is a \$100 **BOOKING FEE**, non-refundable, due at the time of contract signing. This will count towards the total fee.

All payments are due at the conclusion of the last workshop.

TOTAL FEES: _____ (subtract Booking Fee)

Door-to-door travel: current federal reimbursement rate per mile or round trip air fare, parking, tolls, and baggage fees.

Lodging: Hotel/motel with on-site food and free wireless internet preferred; private home in some situations. Gay is allergic to smoke, pet dander, and strong odors (perfumes, soaps, room fresheners). Private bath.

Meals are to be provided or \$40 per day, including travel days.

Cancellations: Contract may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment up to 8 weeks prior to the dates of the contract and before Gay purchases tickets or incurs other expenses. This must be stated in a person-to-person telephone conversation and then confirmed in writing (email or USPS).

Cancellation between 8 and 4 weeks prior to the dates of the contract will require payment of half of the contract fees, plus refunding of any expenses already incurred.

Within 4 weeks of the event, the group is responsible for paying all contract fees, plus incurred expenses.

EXCEPTIONS: If conditions beyond our control prevent Gay from teaching or lecturing it is agreed that this contract may be terminated without a penalty assessed by either party. This includes snow, floor, hurricane, tornado, illness, accident, fire, or serious family emergencies.

Rescheduling may be an option.
